C. Student Eligibility

Students applying for the SECU Foundation Scholarship must be a US Citizen and a North Carolina resident. They must be enrolled in a short-term training program that is **96-hours or more** and **leads to a state-regulated or industry recognized credential that is offered through Continuing Education**. They must fall into one of the following groups:

Must be in one of the following target groups and provide appropriate documentation:

- ___ Unemployment Insurance Claimant (**provide a printout of unemployment**)
- ___ Unemployed Adult (**provide a print out of past wages from DWS/NC Works Career Centers**)
- ___ Underemployed Adult (Individual) earning at or below 200% the federal poverty level (**W2 or most recent 1040 tax return**)
- ___ Military Veteran or spouse (**provide DD214 or DD2**)
- ___ Member of the NC National Guard (**Verification from Unit Commander**)

Scholarship recipients may not be a Director, employee or family member of an employee of the State Employee's Credit Union or SECU Foundation.

Note: Preference will be given to students with limited or no access to financial aid from other programs.
